QUERY	RESPONSE
I am not satisfied with my results, (overall or in a particular subject). What can I do? What are the dates of receipt of requests for remarking?	If candidate has obtained grade aggregate of 4, there is no need for remarking. Fees for remarking: Rs 192 per subject Request for remarking should be made online from 28 May 2021 to 03 June 2021 .
When I will know the outcome of a review/ remarking?	Candidates will be informed of outcome of remarking around mid-June 2021.
If there is a substantial change in my results following the remarking, shall the allocation of school be reviewed?	New school may be allocated if there is a substantial change in results.
Can I take the re-assessment paper on 08, 09 and 10 June 2021?	A letter has been submitted to all candidates eligible for the re-assessment.
When will the re-assessment be held and when will the results be declared?	Re-assessment dates: 08, 09, 10 June 2021 Result date: 18 June 2021
If I succeed in the re-assessment, will I be allocated a school?	Candidates may seek admission at a regional private secondary school.
Is there a fee for re-assessment?	No fee.
Which subjects can I take for the re-assessment?	The subjects are specified in the letter issued by MES.
I obtained good results but was not allocated my first choice of school?	Allocation of seats is based on parental choice, performance (grade aggregate), residence of pupil in the geographical zone and availability of seats in the colleges.
I was allocated a school which I did not choose?	Candidate has not filled enough choices on his/her admission application form. To avoid a 'no school' case, candidate has been proposed an available seat. Possibility of requesting for a transfer through zone directorate (communique will be issued by Ministry in the afternoon of 02 June 2021) or consult list of Private Secondary School to find new school.

QUERY	RESPONSE
I need to change two buses to get to the school allocated. I would want another school.	Possibility of requesting for a transfer through zone directorate (communique will be issued by Ministry in the afternoon of the 02 June 2021) or consult list of Private Secondary Schools to find a new school.
I want to change school. What do I need to do?	
I did not have many options regarding choice of schools in my zone. The school allocated has a bad reputation.	
I reside very near to a particular school but I have been allocated a school which is very far.	Allocation of seats is based on parental choice, performance (grade aggregate), residence of pupil in the geographical zone and availability of seats in the colleges. Request for transfer may be made through zone directorate (communique will be issued by Ministry in the afternoon of the 02 June 2021) or consult list of Private Secondary Schools to find a new school.
I want to know how the schools are allocated? How does it work?	Allocation of seats is based on parental choice, performance (grade aggregate), residence of pupil in the geographical zone and availability of seats in the colleges.
How is it that my friend/ neighbour who obtained similar results was allocated different schools?	It is possible that the parental choice, as filled in the application form, is different.
Can I seek admission in a school managed by SEDEC?	Application opens as from 28 May 2021 in the respective SeDEC colleges.
If I want to seek admission in a school other than the one allocated what can I do?	Request for transfer may be made through zone directorate (communique will be issued by Ministry in the afternoon of the 02 June 2021) or consult list of Private Secondary Schools to find a new school.
What is the extended Programme and how will it function?	The extended Programme is applicable for those who have not met the requirement of PSAC. Students are allowed to complete the Basic Education in 4 years instead of 3.
Why has my friend who will join the extended Programme been allocated a particular school and not me although I obtained much better results?	Candidates who do not meet the PSAC requirement are admitted to the extended stream. Each school must admit at least one class of extended stream.
