CAMBRIDGE – SC/HSC/GCE APRIL/MAY/JUNE 2021 EXAMINATIONS Transport facilities during lockdown period

Kindly note that, during the confinement, the following arrangements have been made with NLTA regarding transport facilities for resource persons appointed by MES (Coordinators/Assistant Coordinators, Supervisors/Assistant Supervisors, Invigilators, School Superintendents and Caretakers):

- 1) Examinations buses will be available in the Red Zone regions for candidates and resource persons;
- 2) Normal Bus services are available in all regions except in the Red Zones;
- 3) In case of any transport problems on examination days, candidates are invited to call on **8923** for necessary arrangements;
- 4) After examinations, in centres where there are over 100 candidates, stand-by buses will be available to transport candidates from schools to the main nearby bus station;
- 5) Buses will be available on main lines up to about two hours after the end of examinations for support staff at examinations centres in the Red Zone regions.

Please inform candidates that they should reach the bus stop/station 15-20 minutes earlier than their usual time.

Kindly note that the hotline mentioned in the SOP-Preventive measures circulated to schools on **Friday 19 March 2021** should read **8923** instead of 8924.
