

# CAMBRIDGE GCE MAY/JUNE 2020 EXAMINATION

## Guidance for Submission of Entries

Read carefully the following before filling in the Entry Application Form

### 1. Online Application

- 1.1. Candidates are **strongly** advised to consult the current syllabuses available at the Syllabus Section of the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate or on the MES website (<http://mes.intnet.mu/>) before making their entry. Please take note of the following **changes** in the syllabuses and codes.

- 1.2. Candidates may enter for up to
- (i) **9 subjects** at Ordinary Level
  - (ii) **4 subjects** at Advanced Level
- 1.3. Candidates will be able to make only **ONE** application online. MES will not make any arrangement in case of clash in timetable with other examining bodies.
- 1.4. Candidates should submit a **valid e-mail address** to receive a notification of entry.
- 1.5. **Entries (for both ‘O’ Level and ‘A’ Level) are not allowed for the same session.**
- 1.6. Amendments after final submission of online application forms are **NOT** allowed. Candidates should inform MES in writing for any amendments they wish to make on their entries after submission of online entries.

### 2. Identity Cards

- 2.1. Candidates who are 18 or above should bring along their National Identity Card on each examination day.
- Those **under eighteen** who do not have NTA Student Identity Card should produce their original A4 format Birth Certificate along with two recent passport-size photographs bearing their name and signature to obtain their Examination Identity/Admission Card at the MES. This Identity/Admission Card will be used to validate the candidate by the Supervisor on each examination day.

### 3. Payment

#### (a) Payment of fees through Internet Banking or Mobile Banking for SBM Account holders

3.1 Payment could be effected electronically through **SBM Internet Banking** or **SBM Mobile Banking Application**. Details of the payment process are available on the MES website.

#### (b) Payment of fees at the MES

3.2. For those candidates effecting payment at the MES, they should call at the MES on the following dates relative to their surname:

3.3. Candidates should bring with them three (3) copies of the email received after their applications to effect payments.

3.4. Payment of fees should be made in **cash** or by **debit** or by **credit card** or by means of an **Office Cheque** issued by a bank drawn to the order of the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate. If payment is made by cash, candidates should tender the exact amount to the Cashier. No payment will be accepted without the hard copies of the online application.

3.5. **Candidates who have submitted an online application but have not effected payment by 26 February 2020 will have their entries cancelled.**

### 4. Online Entry at the MES

4.2. Candidates who have not been able to submit their application online from remote places (*e.g Home, Office*), may call at the MES on the dates mentioned above to complete their application and effect payment.

Candidates should bring along their National Identity Card or NTA Student Identity Card and A4 format Birth Certificate to ensure the correctness of particulars on the application form.

4.3. Candidates should have a valid email address before calling at the MES to fill in the online application form.

4.4. Candidates sitting for GCE 'A' Level May/June 2020 Examinations should consult the '**Notes of Guidance for Syllabuses**' from the MES Website to select the correct Option Code for the following subjects:
