CAMBRIDGE GENERAL CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION EXAMINATION MAY/JUNE 2020

A. ONLINE APPLICATION

Candidates will be able to make their online application by clicking on

- (i) the **GCE May/June 2020 - Entries** link followed by
- (ii) **Online Application** link.
 1. Candidates should follow the instructions given in the “*Guidance for Submission of Entries*” prior to filling the online entry form.
 2. For those candidates who have not been able to process their online application from remote places (*e.g Home, Office*), provision will be made at the MES to complete their online application and thereafter effect payment.
 3. Candidates who are 18 or above should bring along their National Identity Card on each examination day. Those **under eighteen** who do not have NTA Student Identity Card should produce their original A4 format Birth Certificate along with two recent passport-size photographs bearing their name and signature to obtain their Examination Identity/Admission Card at the MES. This Identity/Admission Card will be used to validate the candidate by the Supervisor on each examination day.

B. PAYMENT OF EXAMINATION FEES

1. Payment of fees at the MES

- (a) Candidates effecting **payment at the MES**, should call at the MES on the following dates relative to their surname:

- (b) Candidates should bring with them three (3) copies of the email received to effect payments. Further information is on the "Guidance for Submission of Entries".
- (c) Payment of fees should be made in **cash** or by **debit** or by **credit card** or by means of an **Office Cheque** issued by a bank drawn to the order of the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate. If payment is made by cash, candidates should tender the exact amount to the Cashier

- Payment may be effected electronically through **SBM Internet Banking** or **SBM Mobile Banking Application**. Details of the payment process are available on the MES website.

C. VERY IMPORTANT NOTICE:

- (a) **Candidates who have submitted an online application but have not effected payment by 26 February 2020 will have their entries cancelled.**
- (b) Candidates are strongly advised to be very careful while filling in their Entry Forms as an additional fee will be charged for any amendment made **after 08 March 2020**.
- (c) The GCE May/June 2020 examination will be held from **Monday 20 April to Friday 12 June 2020**. **A provisional timetable is available on the MES website**. Timetables for candidates will be despatched by registered post. Those who would not have received their timetable by **Wednesday 15 April 2020** are requested to call at the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate, Cambridge Examinations Section to collect same on **Thursday 16 April 2020**.
