Either The MES Candidate's Identity/Admission Card or the NTA Student Identity Card together with one recent passport-size photograph bearing their name and signature.

Or Two recent passport-size photographs bearing their name and signature and countersigned by one person who has known them personally for at least two years and who is either Member of the National Assembly, Medical Practitioner, Barrister-at-law, Attorney-at-Law, Notary Public, Bank Manager, Principal of a recognised Educational Institution, Police Officer **not** below the rank of Assistant Superintendent or Officer in the public service **not** below the rank of Assistant Secretary.

The person countersigning the photographs should give his/her own particulars as follows:
